At Petaluma People Services Center (PPSC) our goal is to reduce poverty, physical and mental abuse, chemical dependence, violence, ignorance, isolation and mental illness, among children, adults, families and seniors. PPSC is much more than a collection of 34 human services programs based on best practice research with measurable outcomes. We are a community of caregivers existing within the larger community whose sole purpose is to help make people's lives better. We strive to do this one child, one adult, and one senior at a time. Last year we served over 7,000 people through our programs. The hands-on, face-to-face support that individuals receive from PPSC is wide ranging; counseling, job placement, gang prevention, daily hot meals, rides to the doctor, case management, financial assistance for homeless prevention, informational and referrals....**People Helping People.**

LOW-INCOME FAMILIES AND INDIVIDUALS PUT HEALTHY MEALS ON THEIR TABLE

You may qualify for food stamps even if:

- € You own your home
- € You are working full time
- € You have a good car and money in the bank
- € You are going to school
- € You are living with others

The California CalFresh Program, which the USDA (and some other states) calls SNAP or Food Stamps, has a new name. It is now called CalFresh. The benefits haven't been distributed as "stamps" for years—these benefits help low-income people buy the food needed for good health by way of a debit card that can only be used to buy food items. The purpose of CalFresh is to provide food assistance to end hunger, improve nutrition, and increase health, and the new name is meant to reflect the fact that these benefits are a resource to help low-income families and individuals put healthy meals on their table.
