The associate will provide individual, couple, family and group therapy to their own caseload of clients. This is a paid position that includes individual supervision, group supervision, staff meetings and regular trainings.

### **ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Conduct client intakes and provide individual and group therapy sessions.
- Monitor client progress and treatment plan as needed.
- Maintain appropriate documentation as required, including all notes in electronic medical record system.
- Follow all clinic protocols, participate in all required meetings and clinical supervision.
- Assist in developing curriculum for workshops, and/or therapy groups. May also assist in leading groups or workshops as needed.

- Current BBS registration as a licensed clinician or AMFT, ACSW, or APCC in the state of California.
- Participation in individual supervision, group supervision and trainings.
- Ability to work both independently and as a member of a collaborative team.
- Detail-oriented, proactive, and able to organize and prioritize tasks.
- Excellent communication skills with both clients and colleagues.
- Knowledge of evidence-based therapies.
- Ability to consistently work at least two evenings a week OR one weekend day.
